- 1. **BATTING HELMETS:** The league no longer provides batting helmets for players due to health concerns. This policy was established over 8 years ago. If you have a question about equipment please ask you team manager or a coach.
- 2. EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER: We must have an Emergency Phone Number other than home phone. Please indicate if it is a cell phone, family, friend, etc.

- 5. REFUNDABLE FUNDRAISER: Each family must purchase a book of 60 raffle tickets. The cost is added to the registration fee. The Managers will distribute tickets shortly after Player Draft. The family sells the tickets and returns the stubs to the Concession Stand. The family keeps the \$60.00 they paid at registration for selling their book. The Raffle will be drawn on Saturday, May 31st, 2025.
- 6. **OPENING DAY:** Tentative date, subject to change -- Saturday, April 5th, 2025.
- 7. PICTURES: A Saturday, Sunday, or weeknight in April or May, To Be Determined.
- 8. FAMILY FUN DAY: Tentative dates, subject to change -- Saturday, April 12th, 2025. Rain Date: Saturday, April 19th, 2025.
- 9. ORIOLES DAY & BAYSOX DAY: To Be Determined.

- 10. INSURANCE: Our accidental medical insurance is a secondary coverage policy with a deductible.
- 11. **TEAM MANAGER**: will call to inform you when the first practice will take place. Make sure you get the manager's name and phone number when they call around the second week of March after Player Draft. If registrations are delayed (e.g., inclement weather), it will be later in the month.
- 12. WHERE TEAMS PRACTICE AND PLAY: Sawmill Creek Park (Home Field) on Dorsey Road
- 13. **TIME & SCHEDULES:** Typically 6:00 PM on weekdays and varying times on Saturdays or Sundays. Make-up games might be played on weekdays, Saturdays, or Sundays. Game Schedules will be distributed by Opening Day or as soon as possible.
- 14. UNIFORMS: The league provides complete uniforms for all players. They get to keep their uniform at the end of the season. No other uniforms should be worn at league-scheduled ballgames.

- 17. MANAGER & COACH PROSPECTS: Any returning managers or coaches are invited to apply for a coaching position for 2025. If you happen to be moving up an age group to follow your child, please recommend any coaches you worked with that may be interested in managing a team in the league you're moving up from. Recommendations are the best way to build a list of prospective managers and coaches.
- 18. **TEAM PARENTS:** Team parents collect player packets for team pictures, hand out fundraiser packets, help managers with phone calls and schedule snacks for younger teams, if needed. Please let your manager know if you are interested in helping out with these important tasks.
- 19. **PLAYER DRAFTS:** League Vice Presidents and Managers will meet to draft players on or around Sunday, March 2nd, 2025. It is <u>not</u> necessary for players to attend. This is the meeting where teams will be built.
